

Applications for Membership.

All applicants for membership must be conversant with the GNAS Rules of Shooting and safety practices.

Therefore, any person wishing to become a member of Eastbourne Archers must fulfil one of the following criteria:

- 1) A complete novice shall be required to complete, satisfactorily, a training course organised and run by Eastbourne Archers. A fee for any course will be determined by the club committee.
- 2) A complete novice, who has satisfactorily completed a GNAS recognised training course, of a minimum of 12 hours, at a different venue and has a Certificate of Competency, must also be first assessed by Eastbourne Archers coach(s). (see 5)
- 3) An experienced archer, and member of GNAS, moving from another club shall provide a copy of their personal record showing their current handicap and classification and signed by their previous club's Record's Officer. Their record and standard achieved will determine if further assessment is required by Eastbourne Archers.(see 5)
- 4) An experienced archer, who is a Direct Member of GNAS, will be required to be assessed by Eastbourne Archers, unless said archer is known personally to other member's of Eastbourne Archers who can then vouch for that applicant's knowledge of GNAS Rules and Safety. (see 5)
- 5) A fee may be charged for any assessment that is required and will be determined by the club committee.
- 6) There is no automatic right of membership. All applications for membership shall be approved by the club committee.
